



REMOTE CONFERENCING

6th-12th Grade

WHO?

Remote Conferencing is mandatory for students who are under quarantine due to COVID exposure. Remote Conferencing allows students to avoid excessive absences, which could jeopardize credit or promotion to the next grade.

According to TEA, **one** of the following guidelines must be met in order to participate in Remote Conferencing:

- The student's temporary medical condition is documented by a physician licensed to practice in the United States. The documentation must include a statement from the physician that the student is to remain confined to their home or to a hospital.
- The student has a positive test result for a communicable condition listed in 25 TAC §97.7.
- The student has been identified as having been in close contact with someone COVID-19 positive.

WHAT?

Students will complete work missed while not at school. The Remote Conferencing teacher will be working with the student's teacher(s) to help assist them on any assignments as well as provide learning opportunities when work is not readily available.

WHEN?

Beginning September 14th, a teacher will be available to help your child between 9:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. **Students must log in by 10 a.m. to be counted present for the day.**

WHERE?

Remote Conferencing will be held via Zoom. The sessions will be separated based on grade (Prek-5 & 6-12). Information on how to access the zoom links will be shared with students who qualify under one of the three guidelines.
