## Summary

London ISD is a 3A school district located in Nueces county bounded by expanses of farm and ranch land to west, north and south. The township of London itself exists for only one purpose, the education of our children. LISD serves as the centerpiece of a community made up of agricultural and residential components. LISD contains 98 square miles and serves over 1300 students in grades Pre-K through 12. London ISD works on a year long calendar with students receiving a six weeks long summer and week long intersession after each six weeks grading period.

## Graduation Requirements

All LHS students follow a rigorous course plan to graduate with multiple endorsements and the Distinguished Level of Achievement (as prescribed by Texas Education Agency). Students are able to earn endorsements in all five areas: Arts & Humanities, Public Services, STEM, Business & Industry, and Multidisciplinary Studies.

## Advanced Coursework

Students can begin taking advanced coursework during their freshman year. Due to our small size we rotate classes every year to give our students an opportunity to take as many rigorous courses as possible. Advanced Placement Courses are offered in the following areas: Spanish Language, Biology, Chemistry, Physics 1, Physics C, Calculus AB/BC, Studio Art, Music Theory, and World History. Students also take a wide range of dual credit courses through Del Mar College and UT OnRamps.

Grades are weighted for the following courses: Pre-AP (10 points), AP (15 points), OnRamps (15 points), and dual credit (15 points). The student's weighted GPA is reported on the transcript; only courses taken in grades 9-12 during the regular school year are calculated.

## Class Rank

Because of the competitive nature of London ISD students and tested aptitudes are above the national average, rank in class cannot be regarded as a valid indication of preparation for college for the students at London High School. For this reason, we only report class rank for the top ten percent of the senior class applying to Texas public universities pursuant to Texas Education Code Section 51.803.
